ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

PEOPLES' SELF-HELP HOUSING CORPORATION

OF SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, INC.

ARTICLE I. The name of this Corporation shall be Peoples' Self-Help Housing Corporation of San Luis Obispo County, Inc.

ARTICLE II. The specific and primary purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to promote better housing conditions for the low-income families of San Luis Obispo County.

ARTICLE III. The general purpose and powers for which this Corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To provide low-income families with the opportunity to acquire new homes, to renovate or repair existing homes, to engage in self-help projects, or to sponsor rental or cooperative housing without regard to race, color, creed, or national origin.
- 2. To make and enter into contracts of every sort and kind permitted by law with an individual, firm, association, and private, public, or municipal corporation or body politic or department thereof, for the attainment of the purposes of this Corporation.
- 3. To solicit, collect, receive, acquire, hold, and invest money and property, both real and personal, including money and property received by gift, contribution, bequest, or devise; to sell and convert property, both real and personal, into cash; and to use the funds of this Corporation and the proceeds, income, rents, issues, and profits derived from any property of this Corporation for any of the purposes for which this Corporation is formed.

- 4. To purchase, acquire, own, hold, sell, assign, transfer, dispose of, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, or encumber, and to deal in shares, bonds, notes, debentures, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of any person, firm, corporation, or association, and, while the owner or holder of them, to exercise all rights, powers, and privileges of ownership.
- 5. To purchase or acquire, own, hold, use lease (either as lessor or lessee), sell, exchange, assign, convey, dispose of, mortgage, hypothecate, or encumber real and personal property.
- 6. To borrow money, incur indebtedness, and to secure repayment by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other hypothecation of property, both real and personal.
- 7. To enter into, make, perform, and to carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit on amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation, municipality, county, parish, state, territory, government (foreign or domestic), or other municipal or governmental subdivision.
- 8. To do all things necessary, expedient, or appropriate to the accomplishment of any of the objects and purposes for which this Corporation is formed.
- 9. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities of exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this Corporation.
- 10. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- ARTICLE IV. The Board of Directors shall constitute the membership of the Corporation, and the Corporation shall have no membership distinct from the Board of Directors.
- ARTICLE V. This Corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for nonprofit purposes.
- ARTICLE VI. The principal office for the transaction of business of this Corporation is situated in San Luis Obispo County, California.
- ARTICLE VII. This Corporation shall have perpetual existance.

ARTICLE VIII. The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private persons. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this Corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

If this Corporation holds any assets in trust, or the Corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the superior court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.

ARTICLE IX. The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall consist of the number set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The names and addresses of persons who are to act in the capacity of Directors until the selection of their successors are:

ARTICLE X. The authorized number and qualifications of members of the Corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of this Corporation.



- 2. At a meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation, duly held at San Luis Obispo, California on April 28, 1971, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED,

that ARTICLE XI is added to the Articles of Incorporation and shall read as follows:

ARTICLE XI

- (1) The corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- (2) The corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- (3) The corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- (4) The corporation shall not make any taxable investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- (5) The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- 3. That the members have adopted said amendment by Resolution at a meeting held at San Luis Obispo, California on April 28, 1971, and the wording of the added Article as set forth in the members' Resolution is the same as that set forth in the Directors' Resolution in Paragraph 2 above.

4. That the number of members who voted affirmatively for the adoption of said Resolution is 10, and that the number of members constituting a quorum is 8.
